Since its inception in 2005, Georgia Asylum and Immigration Network (GAIN) has been helping immigrant victims of crime and persecution find safety, freedom, and opportunity in the United States. GAIN was founded as the Atlanta Bar Asylum Project in order to train and support volunteer attorneys taking on pro bono asylum cases. In 2010, GAIN expanded this model to add the Victims of Violence program, serving immigrant victims of human trafficking, domestic violence, sexual assault, and other crimes.

GAIN serves an estimated 550 people annually, including intakes, consultations, and GAIN cases which are placed through either direct representation or pro bono referrals. Since inception, GAIN programs have helped over 5,000 people and provided over 15 million dollars in pro bono legal services for asylum-seekers and immigrant victims of human trafficking, domestic violence, sexual assault, and other crimes.
